I've worked at some of the UK's most respected Drupal based web agencies, including Brightlemon and New Digital Partnership (now NDP Studio) in London and Microserve in Bristol. I have built and styled the front end of 100s of static HTML and Drupal based, dynamic websites, applications and tool sets for many small, medium and large clients, ranging from start-ups to large charities, non-profits to well known brands and organisations such as The British Council, Sky, NHS and Readers Digest.

With an extensive background in Drupal CMS, I have a keen awareness and passion for delivering clients the tools they need to publish and administer the content of their own websites in an intuitive and robust way as possible, also often providing face to face training, written documentation and video guides on how to get the most from their tailored CMS platform. I have also written several tutorial blogs regarding Drupal, Bootstrap and front end development in general and have been responsible for writing in-house Drupal theming guides and creating both fixed and responsive custom boilerplate, starter themes for use by in-house developers.

Having worked with many charities, educational and government clients I'm an advocate and guardian of accessibility and usability. As well as informing my own approach to web development, this has led to often being called upon to audit existing websites and produce reports on their usability, use of web design and Drupal best practices and quality of their front end code.

During my time at NDP I was also actively involved with the architecture and refining of our web specific production processes, in-house training and recruitment.

What is and ISN'T a Front End developer?

I'm not a back end developer. I don't write PHP or Python. I don't implement complicated platform integrations or data migrations. I am also not a SysAdmin or IT guy. A front end developer is the guy that takes the data of a website and then using HTML, CSS, Javascript, grid frameworks etc presents that data to the user, visually on the page, turning it into a pretty, device agnostic, responsive, accessible and usable experience.
